Podar International School, Deolali was established in 2019 and the numbers of students have been rising ever since. The school is flourishing well due to the trust that the parents entrusted to the school.

The year 2022-23 was a challenging year due to the shift in the paradigm of teaching-learning as physical education was shifted to virtual learning. But our teachers and students were determined to face the challenges to obtain knowledge. Thus the teaching-learning process was held online.

The curriculum was shifted towards a blended learning approach. The lesson plans designed by the curriculum Department focused on synchronous, asynchronous learning and flipped classroom methodology.

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SCHOLASTIC:

Activity-based learning:

The lack of physical contact between students and teachers gave rise to innovation. Teachers inculcated various hands-on activities for learning to engage the students in learning. Various techniques such as object method, inquiry-based learning, inductive teaching, and flipped learning were imbibed in the virtual classroom.

Remedial lessons:

Remedial classes were conducted for the students who require extra attention. These sessions not only focused on concept clearing but also focused on the major skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing. The student's performance improved and they were able to be at par with their classmates.

Zero period:

The zero period was given the same priority as other classes in virtual learning. The zero period was held every day for all classes to ensure that the students could clarify their doubts and get an opportunity to create a special bond with their classmates. The LSRW skills of the students were worked upon during this.

CO-SCHOLASTIC:

Co-scholastic is an essential area of school life as they help to enhance the learning process of the students. Through these activities, we strive to bring in social skills, intellectual skills, moral values, personality progress, and character appeal in our students. Some of these events were Card making, Poster making, Best out of waste, projects, etc.

Healthcare Initiatives:

A healthy body leads to a healthy mind and soul. During the unprecedented situation of Covid-19, it was crucial to sustaining the health of our students and their families. For this, the school organized various activities such as,

Yoga:

Virtual Yoga sessions were held every week to keep the students fit physically and mentally. This included various yoga asanas and breathing exercises.

Fit India Week:

The school organized Fit India Week from 1st-7th December. Daily fitness activities such as Yoga, Aerobics, and Zumba. Students were given fitness challenges every day so that they could keep up with the spirit of fitness.

The students were given a demonstration of the precautions and actions they must take when a fire occurs. They were also guided on how to use a fire extinguisher and other tools used during a fire break out.

CO-CURRICULARS:

Celebrations:

To foster the values of national integration, religions, and cultural awareness, and tolerance various national, religions and cultural festivals were celebrated in an online mode this year.

International Yoga Day:

International Yoga Day was celebrated on 21st June to spread awareness about the importance of health. A special theme 'Yoga with daddy' was held to combine the celebration with\Fathers Day.

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Independence Day:

The 76th Independence Day was celebrated with fervor and patriotism. A virtual celebration was held which included the flag hoisting ceremony and cultural program. Students presented various dances, songs, poems, and speeches as homage to the brave freedom fighters of our country.

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Innovative practices:

Experiential learning:

Experiential learning engages students in critical thinking, problem-solving, and decision-making in contexts that are relevant to them. With experiential learning students discover solutions to problems and link their learning with practical knowledge. The students are engaged in various activities where they understand the interdisciplinary nature of learning.

Blended learning:

With the shift in the paradigm of learning to virtual classrooms, we have blended learning as synchronous and asynchronous. Students learn through a blend of synchronous activities such as discussions, debates, and peer learning. Whereas asynchronous activities such as revisiting the taught concepts through videos, games, and worksheets help students to recall their knowledge and apply it.

Art integration:

Art integration is an integral part of the student experience. Through integration of arts with learning students get an opportunity to explore, reflect and respond to knowledge embedded in language, memory, and story. Each lesson consists of art integrated activities which are inter related to various subjects. Students also develop empathy and respect for the voices, traditions and creations of others through these.

Symphonics:

Symphonics is the in-house phonics program. Symphonics is a skillful method for teaching, reading, and writing the English language by correlating sounds of the letters with the alphabet. The program helps the students of grades 1-3 to develop their reading, writing, and speaking skills. Along with this, all students' reading skills are assessed every month.

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Power Math kit activities:

As we promote more hands-on learning experiences for our students, power math activity is an integral part of learning Mathematics. The kit includes various items such as number tiles; cards; grid; names, abacus kit, plane, and solid shapes, clock. This helps the learners to learn complex concepts through simple kinaesthetic activities.

Emphasis on LSRW skills:

The key to improvement is laying a strong foundation. To make the learners ready for the most important skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing we have curated a special slot in the zero period which focuses on these skills. The learners are guided and assessed using various methods to enhance their abilities.

3D Printing technology:

To equip our students with the skills of the 21st century, our students have been introduced to 3D printing technology. The students are learning how to create 3D models with layering materials. The students are learning how to create models such as electric circuit, houses through this technology. This will help them to find solutions to the modern problems and to create a sustainable environment.

Overall Results:

Examination is an important component of a student's progress. Our students' performances have been exemplary. To prepare our students for the exams, diagnostic and achievement tests were conducted before and after the chapter. Along with this remedial classes were planned and executed for students who required extra support. Revision worksheets were conducted for grades 1 and 2 whereas the students of grades 3 to 7 attempted their virtual examination through the Eklavya and Betweenus portal. Our students outshined the exams with the majority of our students scoring above 70%.

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PTA/SMC Activities:

To reduce the gap between the student's progress and their accomplishments PTA meetings were held in the year. The meetings focused on the challenges faced for students' development and how to overcome them. The meetings resulted in building new opportunities for the students.

Student Enrichment program:
