• Inception

Podar International School, Gangapur Road, Nashik was inaugurated on 20th June 2019 under the society of Podar Charity Trust, with students from grade I to VI, in a newly built pristine green campus.

The session began with Parent Orientation to make the new parents aware of the system, examination pattern, platforms of communication and introduce the parents with the annual plan and calendar.

• Staff Development

The School started with 10 teachers, a librarian, a nurse, a counselor, 3 office staff and 10 supporting staff.

Newly appointed office staff, teachers and the Principal received a number of trainings to get accustomed to all the special features of a Podar School.A three-day long E2S program was conducted for the Principal.Our committed team of teachers undertook a series of trainings throughout the year to update their teaching and assessment methods.

Grooming and etiquettes session was conducted by the Principal Mrs. Moumita Choudhury for the Staff to instruct them on matters of personal hygiene and work ethics and professional dress code.English Speaking trainings were conducted for the teachers to refine their communication skills.Staffs are continuously assessed by conducting peer observation and microteaching sessions.To enrich their teaching skills,trainings were conducted on Bloom's taxonomy and different methodologies.Special training sessions were conducted on Integrated English,Thematic Unit, Symphonic and on how to use 'Wordsworth Software'.Teachers also attended trainings on Creative thinking,decision making and team work.
