PODAR INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL (CIE), KALYAN UNIFORM POLICY made by PTA 2018-19

OBJECTIVE

The objective of wearing a school uniform is it gives students a sense of belonging to a particular school and creates an identity for the school in the community. It also promotes a sense of pride in the school and engenders a feeling of community and belonging. In addition, it encourages uniformity and decreases disparity.

AIM(s) # Our policy is based on the notion that a school uniform:

- is practical and smart;
- identifies the children with the school;
- is not distracting in class (as fashion clothes might be);
- makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance;
- is regarded as suitable, and good value for money;
- Has been designed with health and safety in mind.

<u>GIRLS</u>

Blue Denim Skirt (knee length with School Logo) ,White Shirt (Full Sleeves), Red T-shirt (with School Logo),Pink T-shirt with Grey Track Pants (PE Uniform),Black Socks, Black Shoes, Navy Blue Blazer, I Card. **BOYS**

Blue Denim Jeans/Shorts*(with School Logo), White Shirt (Full Sleeves), Red T-shirt (with School Logo), Blue T-shirt with Grey Track Pants (PE Uniform), Black Socks, Black Shoes, Navy Blue Blazer, I Card.

*(Grade 1 – 4 boys are required to wear School Shorts)

Students participating in Inter School Competitions(or participating in any competition) as well as Independence Day, Republic Day required to wear White school Shirt, School Jeans/ school shorts, Black socks, Black school shoes, Blazer along with I Card.

For Picnic, the kids are required to wear Red T-shirt with grey track pants, black socks and black shoes.

For extra-curricular sports clubs such as football, children may bring their own suitable kit with outdoor footwear. It is COMPULSORY for the kids to wear I CARD daily to school.

Jewellery and Wrist watches # On health and safety grounds, the school **does not allow** children to wear ANY jewellery, band and watches in school.

Hair # The school does not permit children to have haircuts that could serve as a distraction to other children. This includes 'fashion' haircuts.

Boys are required to key their hair short. Shaved haircut, brush-cut over the ears, spiky hair not allowed.

Girls with **long hair** are required to make two plaits tied with plain black hair band at the end. Shoulder length hair girls are required to make a single or 2 pony, tied with plain black hair band.

Girls with **short hair** are required to tie their hair with black head band or pin up properly so that hair does not come in the eyes.

Girls are not allowed to use hair clutches(neither black nor any other colour). Only black hair band and plain black coloured pins are to be used in school.

NO HAIR COLOUR OR HAIR EXTENSIONS ARE PERMITTED BY THE SCHOOL.

Nail Polish& Mehandi # Nail polish should not be worn by pupils at any time. If a pupil does wear polish, they are required to remove it at home before coming to school the next day. The school does not allow students to put/wear Mehandior any tattoos.

Footwear # Only plain, black footwear is permitted in school. There must be no designer labels, logos or markings on shoes. The school wants all children to grow into healthy adults. We believe that it is dangerous for children to wear shoes with platform soles or high heels in school, so we do not allow this.

Correct uniform as **per the timetable** must be worn at all times. **Only Navy Blue Blazer is to be worn in school**. **No other jackets, cardigans, fleeces etc. will be allowed** to be worn inside the school building.PE t-shirts should have no logos other than the school logo, on them.

All uniform rules need to be followed during EXAM DAYS as well. Violation of uniform policy during exam is strictly prohibited.

Socks # The Schools requires the students to wear **ONLY PLAIN BLACKCOLOURED SOCKS**.

Birthday Dress # The school **does not object** in kids wearing colourful dress on their birthday. The **dress worn must decent**, **not revealing and must be comfortable enough to do the school activities and physical exercise(s).** (The kid **will not be exempted** from any PE or any other activity because of his /her birthday) The following **SHOULD NOT** be worn:

- Short Skirts /Dresses
- Sandals, high/stacked heels
- Low cut dresses or tops
- Strapless, halter, tube tops
- Oversized shorts/pants worn low on hips
- Excessive make-up/large jewellery
- T-shirts with advertisement and inappropriate language/pictures

Consequences for Non-Compliance

If the student twice fails to comply with the uniform policy, the school will send the child back home the third time. (The parents are requested to check the diary daily, in case there is any note/communication from the teacher regarding NON COMPLIANCE)

If mistake is made repeatedly, parents will be called to the school.

We ask/seek the cooperation of parents in ensuring the compliance before the student arrives at school. School reserved the right for change/modify of the policy any time.
