VOLUNTARY MOBILE DEVICE AGREEMENT (prepared & modified by PTA) B.Y.O.D. (Bring Your Own Device) Policy 2.0

In our mission to provide 21st century learning in schools, students may bring their iPad/tab to school. Any device brought from home will be used as learning devices for communication, collaboration, creativity, and productivity. If a learning device is brought to school from home, it is the responsibility of the student.

The school is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged devices or anything similar. Bringing a device is optional and may not be allowed in all classes by teachers. Students will not be penalized for having one device on campus with a signed mobile device agreement on file with the school office. Use of device to enhance learning in the classroom will be pursued when deemed appropriate at individual teacher discretion. All students will have equal access to the curriculum and receive an appropriate credit on assignments whether submitted electronically on mobile devices or using paper and pen/pencil based on the teacher's established grading criteria.

Students, while bringing and using personal device to school, must follow all School policies and the guidelines set in this document. It is a privilege, rather than a right, for a student to bring personal technology device to school. When the policies are followed, our learning environment will be enhanced. However, when policies are abused, the privileges may be taken away and confiscation and/or disciplinary action may occur.

All students must adhere to the following standards of responsible use:

- Technology, including electronic communication, should be used for appropriate educational purposes only and should be consistent with the educational objectives of the school.
- Students must behave ethically and responsibly, even when technology provides them the freedom to do otherwise.
- Students must use the school filtered wireless network during the school day on personal electronic device. Students may not use personal dataplan(s) while at school to access the internet.
- Students assume the risk if they bring personal device to school. The school will not Investigate or look for lost/stolen device.
- Students must not access, modify, download, or install computer programs, files, apps or information belonging to others.
- Students must not waste or abuse school resources through unauthorized system use (e.g., playing online games, downloading music, watching video broadcasts, etc.).
- Students must not alter computers, networks, printers or other equipment except as directed by a teacher.
- Students must not release personal information on the Internet or electronic communications.
- Students must never log onto another student's account.
- If a student finds an inappropriate site or image, he or she must immediately minimize the program and contact the instructor.
- Students must not create, publish, submit or display any materials/media that are abusive, obscene, sexually oriented, threatening, harassing, damaging to another's reputation, or illegal and will report any instances encountered.

- No SIM card will be allowed if you bring mobile phone. No Recording, voice/video calls will be allowed.
- Students may not use the device to record, transmit, or post photographic images, sound, or video of a person or persons on campus during school activities and/or hours, unless otherwise directed by a teacher for specific educational purpose.
- Using social network in school will be sticky prohibited.
- Students shall adhere to all laws and statutes related to issues of copyright or plagiarism.
- Students acknowledge that the school's network filters will be applied to one's connection to the Internet and student will not bypass or attempt to bypass them.
- Device may only be used to access files on computer or Internet sites that are relevant to the classroom curriculum. Games are not permitted, unless otherwise allowed by a teacher.
- Students may not turn on or activate a cell phone or other electronic device during testing or assignments unless allowed by a teacher.
- Students must comply with all teacher requests regarding technology, such as shutting down, closing screen, storing, etc.
- Students will not print from personal devices unless allowed by a teacher.
- The school has the right to collect and examine any device that is suspected of causing problems that violate either a school rule or law of the state of Maharashtra as defined.
- Students should bring their charged devices to school.
