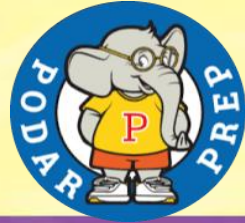

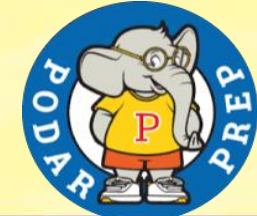

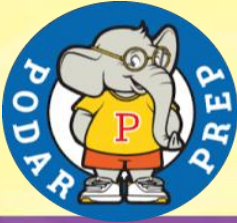


Result of IMO, SOF & IGKO certificate Distribution Result
